CALVARY-SOTH PARTNERSHIP TEAM REPORT

Reprinted from the Calvary Lutheran Church of Edina newsletter

Throughout this summer a team, comprised of congregational members from both Calvary Lutheran Church (CLC) and Shepherd of the Hills (SOTH), has been

meeting to discuss opportunities for the two congregations to develop a more formal partnership following Calvary's last Celebration Worship Service. On the Calvary Team is Pastor Wade, Steve Manacek, Cindy Morris, Alyson Purdy and Becky Rorke. On the SOTH team is Pastor Yolanda, Adam Driscoll and Bruce Nelson. The group has been tasked to identify opportunities to share in God's mission together. Our hope is that we can partner in sharing our gifts and talents with one another, enjoy continuing fellowship in faith and serve the broader community we love.

Although many of the specifics are still being finalized, there are a few plans that we, as a team, wish to share with our congregations. The Calvary Council has reviewed and approved this basic outline:

- Following Calvary's last service on Oct. 1, 2023, the congregation of Shepherd of the Hills welcomes the Calvary members to join them in worship, fellowship and to participate in any of the SOTH programs. This is a wonderful opportunity for the two congregations to meet and get to know each other. It also provides an opportunity for the Calvary members to continue to worship and fellowship together, but within a larger congregation.
- On October 8, 2023, SOTH is planning a welcoming worship service for the Calvary members. Pastor Wade will be there and have a role in worship leadership that day.
- A "Partnership Plan" has been outlined and is currently being refined. It will describe the roles, programs, and funding of the initial integration of the two congregations. The Partnership Plan was reviewed and approved by the Calvary Church Council and will be presented at Calvary's Congregation Meeting on September 17, 2023. If it is approved, it will then be sent to the SOTH Council for review and action.
- The Partnership Plan contemplates Pastor Wade continuing in a part-time role providing pastoral care, regular preaching and worship leadership, and leading WoW or other adult bible studies through 2024. It also contemplates Daryl leading a one-service-per month "festival choir" and an adult handbell choir. A portion of Calvary's sale proceeds would be set aside for development of one or more new ministry initiatives to be developed by a joint committee and approved by both councils sometime in 2024.



SHEPHERDS OF LIGHT

Shepherds of Light (Pre-K to 5th grade) begins Sunday mornings starting September 24.

Students will begin in worship and leave after the kids' message, returning around the Sharing of the Peace so that they can participate in the Lord's Prayer and the Lord's Supper. Once a month, we will bring Communion to them, and they will stay in their classrooms until the end of the service. We will be following the Spark curriculum which correlates with the weekly message you will hear during worship. If your child does not have a SPARK Bible, please let us know and we will gladly get one for them.


